

We have created ONE new club in 6 Years

Where are we now?

District 1080

- We had 1689 members at July 2019.
- By the 1st July 2020 we had 1603 members.
- By the 23rd March 2021 we had 1547 members!
- We have recruited 30 new members since the start of this Rotary year (by the end of Feb 2021)

What's happening?

Club numbers 2020/21

27 Clubs – no change

26 Clubs – lost members

14 Clubs have gained

Inside 12 months: 154

Between 12 – 24 months: 202



Reasons for leaving

Personal: 296

Death: 120

Work: 110

Still - Where are we now?

Current Membership breakdown

Members aged over 70 – 42% (526 unreported)

Overall %

Male – 84%

Female – 16%

We're in Region 21, with 25 Districts
Only Districts 1150 and 1190 have less females

RGBI

- ACTUAL
- Currently losing one District a year by numbers
- 2,000 net loss in 2020

PREDICTED

- In 10 years time we'll be half the number we are today.
- If every District starts 3 new Clubs every year for 10 years –
 We'll have a standstill model!
